1	7 Oct	Tone How to start a painting and working on a coloured ground. Painting a still life using tones of grey/black & white, focusing on light and shade.	No
2	14 Oct	Colour Understanding how colour works looking at colour relativity, complementary colours, mixing neutral colours.	No
3	21 Oct	Interior & Texture Use the studio environment as the subject for more creative painting, whilst also discovering how to get different textures using paint mediums.	No
4	28 Oct	Still Life Work on one painting using colour over two weeks, combining what was learnt about tone and colour in the previous weeks.	No
5	4 Nov	Still Life Work on one painting using colour over two weeks, combining what was learnt about tone and colour in the previous weeks.	No
6	11 Nov	Portraits Looking at varied examples of portrait paintings and the use of tone, colour and mark-making to paint a convincing and exciting image. Selecting an example to copy to practice mixing flesh colours and gain confidence painting a head.	No
7	18 Nov	Self Portrait Two week self portrait. Focusing on the structure of the head in this lesson.	No
8	25 Nov	Self Portrait Continuation of two week self portrait. Developing the colour and painting the features.	No
9	2 Dec	Photographs In this session students will be asked to bring in an image that they would like to base a painting on. The class will look at how to work from photos to create a painting of a more personal nature.	No
10	9 Dec	Photographs Continue and finish the painting started in the previous week.	No
