21 Oct	<p><b>Still Life</b>            Through still life students will focus on measurement, positive and negative space, understanding tone, colour and composition.</p>  <p><i>(Andrew Hitchcock)</i></p>	No
22 Oct	<p><b>Life</b>            The focus of the day is painting the model through a series of poses using tone and simple mark-making techniques.            The day will finish with students painting the model in one long pose with particular focus on measuring and skin tones.</p>	Yes



**Are there any other costs? What else should I bring each lesson?**

You will need to bring your own painting materials to the class, which you can store at The Art Academy for the duration of the course. If you do not have your own materials, we recommend you order an **Acrylic Painting Pack** at the time of booking, which will be available when you arrive for your first class. There is also a mini shop in the studio that supplies the basics such as canvas boards, paints, Zest-it etc. (cash purchases only). An old shirt or apron would be advantageous. Students may bring in their own choices of objects for a still life on the first day.

- A set of bristle brushes, both flat and round, suitable for either oils or acrylics
- One tear off palette (9"x12")
- One palette knife
- One 10"x 12" canvas board

- 8 Daler Rowney (*System 3*) acrylic tubes: Mars Black, Titanium White, Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Umber, Sap Green and Yellow Ochre
