Date for submission – 5th May 2015

Process of Submission - This Prize is for Diploma students only. If you wish to apply please add to your Level 2 essay submission, 250 words explaining how you would make use of the prize and why it would be particularly beneficial to you.

Your Level 2 essay, will also be considered when judging your entry (but the subject does not need to relate to your submission text)

Your contribution in Art Theory classes will also be taken into account as will your engagement with the contextualisation of your practice.

Date for Judging - students will be informed by the 22nd May 2015

Judging Criteria

- The ability to critically analyse and discuss art works and show an understanding of its historic and contextual significance.
- A use of art theory to develop and inform the student's own artistic practice.
- A passion for learning and development of academic knowledge

Structure of Prize

1 student will be awarded the prize.

They will be given 6 hrs of David Hodge's time to make use of as they wish, they can use it for discussion, visits or research.

This time must be used up by the end of the Academic Year, it can be used to further their dissertation or for study in a completely different area.
