Date	Topics/ Skills covered	Model?
22 July 2019	<p>The day will begin with an introductory talk and instructions on how to measure. You will then work through the following and begin your portrait bust:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - establishing the pose - working around the armature - Learning how and what to measure - establishing "truths" - blocking-in the head - establishing symmetry <p>At this point you will also be able to discuss the option to have work hollowed and fired by the Art Academy after the course. For this the following fees apply: £20 for hollowing and £20 for firing (so a total of £40).</p>	YES
23 July 2019	<p>On day 2 you will continue blocking-in and establish the position of the shoulders. The class will also learn how to employ box measurements to establish major structures and symmetry.</p>	YES
24 July 2019	<p>Day 3: You will focus on becoming more aware of and establishing the many profiles running around the form, particularly the 3 quarter views of the model.</p>	YES
25 July 2019	<p>Day 4: Today you should develop and refine observations through more subtle and precise measurements.</p> <p>At this point you may wish to photograph your work to gain more objectivity (making sure not to photograph the model unless express permission is given).</p>	YES
26 July 2019	<p>On the final day you will use insights gained from analysing your photographs to refine the work.</p> <p>Also you should think about the finished piece, discussing materials with your tutor as well as possible casting and firing options.</p> <p>Should you choose to have your work hollowed and fired at the Academy you'll need to complete the form for this and pay the fee (as mentioned above) of £40.00 in the office.</p>	YES
