23 November 2019	Clay: You will spend the first day creating a clay figure sculpture from a life model. In the morning, you will do a number of quick 'sketches' in clay and be shown different ways of looking at the figure, moving from representational to more abstract. In the afternoon you will work from one pose and learn observational, measuring and modelling techniques. The firing process will be discussed.	YES
24 November 2019	Plaster: On the second day you will work with plaster. You will learn how to mix and apply it to a wire armature to produce a sculpture in plaster and mixed media. Various techniques and finishes will be covered with individual discussion that will progress to creating a personal work. You will have guidance and support and do not need to worry if you have nothing in mind until you arrive for the course. You will also have the opportunity to cast objects in plaster to learn more about the medium and its uses and applications.	NO
