27 August 2019	Fundamental Skills of Drawing and Painting: Introduction to the fundamentals of drawing and painting, including line, tone, and gesture. Students will explore colour, composition, and paint application through a still life painting, followed by a creative painting session which introduces music and movement. The tutor will discuss with each student individually to determine their specific interests and goals for the course.	NO
28 August 2019	Painting the Figure: Starting with a discussion of the body in art, students will develop a full painting of the life model. Students will learn key skills to observe and depict the figure, along with basic anatomy, and composition.	YES
29 August 2019	Clay Figure Sculpture: The day starts with an introduction to the principles of figure sculpture. Students will then learn how to model the figure and complete their full pose over the day.	YES
