8 October 2020	<b>Course Introduction and Still Life Exercises</b> Intro to the course and each other through engaging still life exercises: drawing objects by feel and sight, finding marks to articulate and convey texture, weight, material, surface, etc.	NO

29 October 2020	<b>Life Drawing: Colour in Drawing</b> Exercises to understand how colour and tone relate. Introduction to colour theory and how colour conveys mood.	YES
5 November 2020	<b>Portrait</b> Drawing from a portrait model to better understand how to draw the human head and face.	YES
12 November 2020	<b>Self Portrait</b> Using mirrors to create a self portrait.	NO
19 November 2020	<b>Life Drawing: Rhythm and Movement</b> Finding ways to respond to a figure in motion.	YES
