Date	Topics/ Skills covered	Model
9 July 2022	Tone: Working with a limited tonal palette, students will practice mixing and applying paint. Using a still life, students will learn how to draw out the forms and develop a basic tonal, creating form by looking at the play of light and shadow.	NO
16 July 2022	Volume & Tone: Continuing with a limited tonal palette, students will be working from the life model and start exploring portraiture, focusing on tone to create volume. Looking at artists such as Auerbach & Giacometti, we'll see how expressive portraiture can be through the use of mark making.	YES
23 July 2022	Colour: After a basic introduction to mixing colours, students will work from a simple still life. The focus will be on developing and understanding of how colour works; looking at colour relativity, complementary colours, mixing neutral colours.	NO
30 July 2022	Portrait week one: Working over two weeks you will develop a portrait painting. We will look at stylisation and how this can affect your palette and paint marks.	YES 1 of 2
